Millicent Club Champion Harry Coote was selected to play in Royal Adelaide's 2021 Simpson Cup Pennant Team.

The team enjoyed a good win in last weeks Round 2 when it defeated Glenelg 4/3, the first time in many years.

Course Maintenance Update - from the Greens Committee

Greens

The greens have been scarified and the surrounds are currently being made larger with some changes being made and more to come in following weeks.

Bunkers

Bunkers are constantly being worked on. Could we all please follow some simple guidelines.

Please only rake the raked area of the bunkers.

All other areas outside that area please turn rake over and smooth it out and then place the rake back into the middle bottom of the bunker.

Fairways - over the last month fairways have been aerated and fertilizer has recently been put out. The low hanging branches that make it difficult for the rough cutter and also your backswing, have been trimmed off. There is still more to be done with low hanging branches.

Tree roots along side of the 14th green have been removed but there are still more to be done there as well. Some feral pine trees have been cut down behind the sixth men's tee and elsewhere. Some walkways have been widened for the ladies from the seventh green to the eighth tee and for the men's from the 10th green to the 11th tee. There is still some ongoing spraying of the Parramatta grass on the fairways.

Thanks to all the Volunteers who are currently working to make our golf course as good as it is looking and playing at the moment. Also anyone who wants to help out at anytime please you are more than welcome as there's always plenty of work to be done. Contact Anthony Driessen.
